Mobile Pharmacy

The Mobile Pharmacy is designed to provide on-site mobile medical pharmacy services for hospitals, clinics and pharmacies renovating their service area and to provide rapid pharmacy services where none exists today including emergency situations and large-scale disaster areas.



The Mobile Pharmacy is a stand-alone pharmacy designed for optimal workflow and space usage including an office, pharmacy counter and retail pharmacy space fully furnished with pharmacy shelves.

Development of Mobile Pharmacy in Japan

- A profound lesson from the Great East Japan Earthquake (11/March/2011).
- First Mobile Pharmacy was launched in Miyagi. And the Mobile Pharmacies has been expanded in Oita, Wakayama, Hiroshima and Tottori.
- The Mobile Pharmacies were respond to the Kumamoto Earthquake from Oita, Hiroshima and Wakayama.
- It was demonstrated that The Mobile Pharmacy was extremely useful for disaster support activity.
